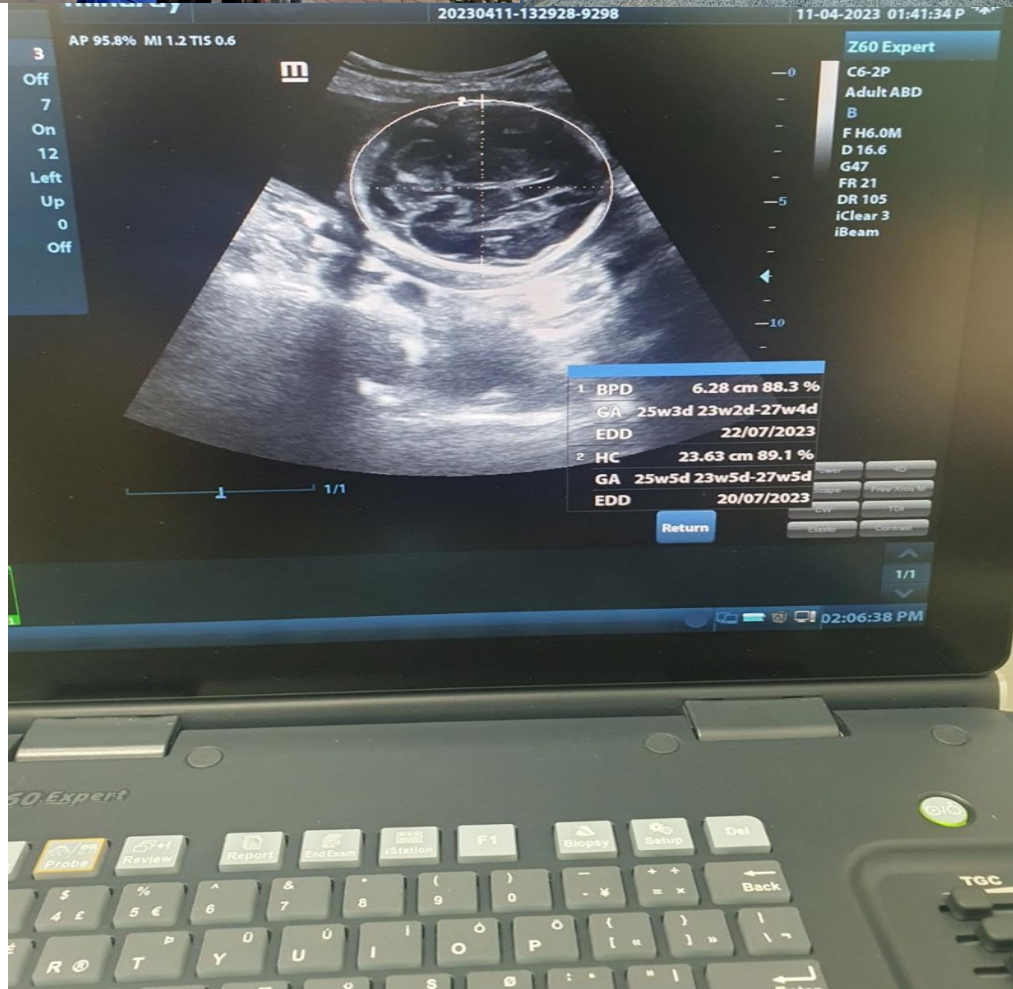


BADR UUNIVERSITY -NEW CLINC & CENTER I care project (Erasmus +project 618674-EPP-1-2020-1-SE

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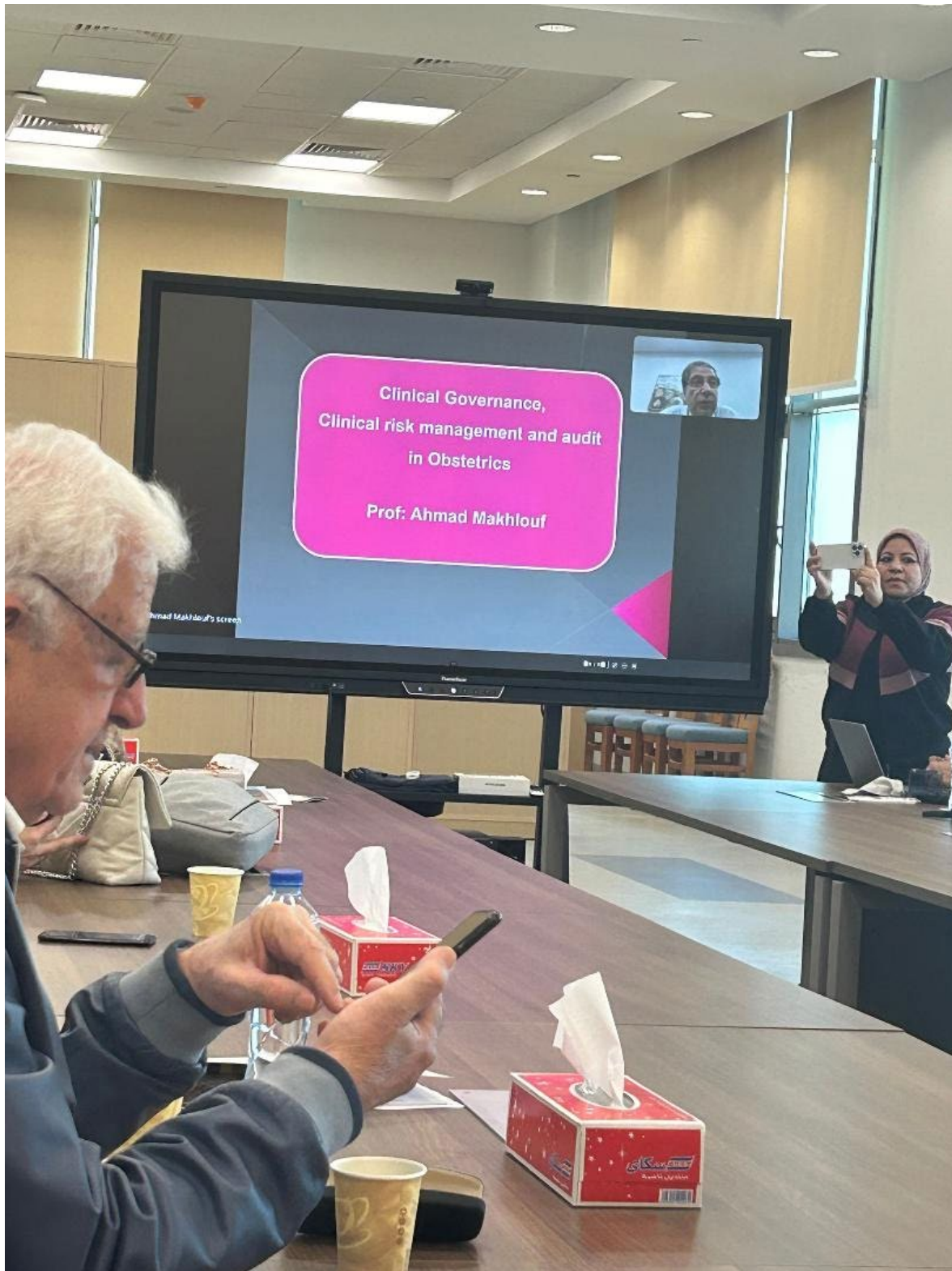
